Minutes:

EECO Farm Tests:

Kim Shaw will present the final results from the Soil Testing at EECO Farm to the East Hampton Town Board Work Session at 10am on Tuesday Dec 6, 2016. EH/Sag Harbor CAC members are invited to attend or watch on Channel 21 if not available to attend.

On a related issue it was mentioned that the Food Pantry Farm has officially changed their name to Share The Harvest Farm.

Encroachment Issues on West Drive from a Property on Washington Avenue:

JB DosSantos has advised the resident on West Drive to take photos of the large pile of dirt/mulch on a Washington Ave property and submit a complaint to Code Enforcement. In addition, Ed Geus will try to photograph and provide to the Committee to review.

New Business

EH/Sag Harbor CAC Membership:

Several members will be resigning from the EH/Sag Harbor CAC including, Rob Coe, Dan Cohen, Paul Fiondella, Kay Hutton and Ilissa Meyer. It was decided that we should reach out via media to attract new members including an Ad in The East Hampton Star, A crawl on LTV and PSA on WLNG, WEHM and WPPB etc. Katy Casey agreed to take the lead and contact these organizations with the objective of inviting prospective members to attend beginning with the January 9, 2017 meeting.

Sanctuary Town Status for East Hampton Town?:

Ilissa Meyer informed the EH/Sag Harbor CAC that discussions have begun on the Anti-Bias Task Force regarding declaring East Hampton a Sanctuary Town, which basically means that local law enforcement will not cooperate with I.C.E. (Immigration & Customs Enforcement). Anthony Liberatore made a motion that Sylvia Overby request that the East Hampton Town Board to explore the establishment of East Hampton Town as a “Sanctuary Town”. Jola Marcario seconded the motion. Motion carried.

School Bus Depot:

There have been many complaints about the recently announced location of the new School Bus Depot regarding noise and traffic. The depot is scheduled to be built behind the East Hampton High School on Cedar St just West of Hand’s Creek. The committee discussed another potential location on Springs Fireplace Road at the scavenger waste dump. It was suggested to attend the School Board Meeting on Tuesday December 6, 2016 @ 6:30pm and raise this issue as it is not currently on the agenda.

Fowler House:

Prudence Carabine informed the committee that Fowler House needs immediate donations/funding of at least \$750 to pay critical bills.
