AIRPORT NEWS:

FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION ISSUES “LOCATION IDENTIFIER” LETTERS – JPX -- to NEW EAST HAMPTON TOWN AIRPORT SLATED TO OPEN, UNDER LOCAL REGULATIONS, ON MAY 19

AIRCRAFT OPERATORS INVITED TO APPLY TO THE TOWN OF EAST HAMPTON FOR PERMISSION TO SEEK FAA APPROVAL TO USE PRIVATE INSTRUMENT PROCEDURES (“Special Procedures”) BEING DEVELOPED FOR EH TOWN AND NEW AIRPORT

East Hampton Town’s airport manager, Jim Brundige, has issued a letter to airport users regarding the application process for use of the special instrument procedures.

Aircraft operators must have the FAA’s permission to use the special procedures. In order to apply to the FAA, they must have the consent of East Hampton Town.

Completed application packages received on or before April 8, 2022 will be forwarded by the Town to the FAA for processing, with the goal of having the special procedures use authorization issued on or before the opening of the new airport on May 19, 2022.

In other airport news, the FAA has issued notice to the town that its National Flight Data Center has assigned **JPX** as the location identifier letters for the new East Hampton Town Airport, effective as of May 19. Access the notification:
