RESOLUTION 2015-896

Authorize Proposed Solutions for Dune Crossover and Drainage Issues Regarding Downtown Montauk Stabilization Project

WHEREAS, the United States Army Corps of Engineers has undertaken the Fire Island to Montauk Point Storm Damage Reduction Project Reformulation Study and the Downtown Montauk Stabilization Project ("Project") in conjunction with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation ("DEC"); and

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of East Hampton authorized local sponsorship in connection with the Project by Resolution No. 2014-1412 adopted on November 20, 2014; and

Whereas, the United States Army Corps of Engineers and New York State Department of Conservation has been working, together with the Town of East Hampton, to address details regarding the implementation of the Project including dune crossovers and specific drainage issues; and

Whereas, the DEC has issued a letter to the Town of East Hampton, dated July 31, 2015, outlining proposed solutions to the dune crossover and drainage issues that were raised in connection with the Project; and

Whereas, specifically, the DEC proposes designating ten, at grade sand paths for dune crossovers for private property owners marked by sand fencing and plantings; and

Whereas, the DEC proposes two drainage solutions to remedy drainage issues that arose at Lowenstein Court and South Edison Street including the installation of a manhole and pipe to be constructed in part by the US Army Corps of Engineers and lowering the level of the geotextile dune for drainage purposes where necessary; and

Whereas, the NYS DEC requested acknowledgement from the Town of East Hampton accepting the proposed solutions and timelines associated therewith related to the dune crossover and drainage issues; and now therefore be it

Resolved, that the Town Board of the Town of East Hampton hereby accepts and approves of the proposed solutions and timelines set forth in the DEC's letter dated July 31, 2015, to address the private dune crossovers and Lowenstein Court and South Edison Street drainage issues that arose in connection with the implementation of the Downtown Montauk Stabilization Project and; and be it further

Resolved, that the Town Board accepts the responsibilities outlined in the DEC's July 31, 2015 letter, relating to the proposed solutions for dune crossovers and drainage; and be it further

Resolved, that the Town Board hereby directs the Town Clerk to forward a copy of this resolution to the DEC and the US Army Corps of Engineers.
