

The following resolution was offered by <u>COUNCILMAN JOB POTTER</u>, seconded by Councilwoman Mansir, and adopted:

WHEREAS, pursuant to § 247 of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, the Town Board held a public hearing on June 16, 2005 to consider the acquisition of approximately +- 13.5 acres of land located in Montauk, which lands are identified on the Suffolk County Tax Map as SCTM #300-19-10-2,3,4.1,8.1,18,21 & 300-19-9-29; and

WHEREAS, the proposed purchase price for fee simple acquisition of the subject properties is \$750,000.00, plus survey, title, prorated tax, and recording charges; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of said acquisition is preservation of open space; and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of the subject properties is classified as a Type II Action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and

WHEREAS, the Town Board finds, pursuant to § 64-e (8) of the New York Town Law, that acquisition of the subject properties by purchase is the best alternative, of all reasonable alternatives available to the Town, for protection of the community character of the Town of East Hampton, and that such acquisition would be in the best interests of the Town;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Supervisor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract of sale with the record owner of the subject properties, reputedly **JOSEPH G. FARRELL, Jr. (Farrell Building Co.),** for the purpose of acquiring said properties at a cost to the Town of East Hampton not to exceed \$ 750,000.00, plus reasonable survey, title, prorated tax, and recording charges; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that pursuant to contract the Supervisor is authorized and directed to execute any documents and the Town Budget Officer is directed to pay the purchase price and any and all reasonable survey, title, prorated tax, and recording charges, as may be necessary to effect the transfer of titles; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that pursuant to § 64-e of the New York Town Law, the acquisition of subject properties also includes the acquisition of development rights and the right of the Town Board to transfer such rights at a future date; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, the monies to be expended for purchase of the foregoing properties shall be drawn from the Town of East Hampton Community Preservation Fund Budget Account; and be it further
