Public Comment Period Open for NYS Police Reform Mandate

On Thursday, October 29, 2020, the East Hampton Town Board in conjunction with East Hampton Town Police Chief Michal Sarlo held a listening session to begin the collaborative process of developing a plan to ensure mutual trust and respect between our community and our dedicated police force, as mandated by New York State.
