

AMSTERDAM BEACH PRESERVE

Amsterdam Beach is a partnership in preservation owned by the State of New York, the County of Suffolk and the Town of East Hampton. The nearly 200 acres of wetland, woodland and shoreline offers some spectacular views and trails. In the Fall of 2011, cutting of the approved trail system in the Amsterdam Beach Preserve commenced. A number of volunteers from the East Hampton Trails Preservation Society have been working alongside State, County and Town personnel to open up trails marked by Department employees. A one mile loop has already been completely cleared. An access trail from the corner of Ranch Road and Montauk Point State Parkway, where in the coming months an official parking area will be built, a spur leading from the loop, and a connection to the Paumanok Path are being created as well. We look forward to announcing the grand opening soon!
