At the October 27th, 2014 meeting of the SCAC the following resolution was passed by a vote of 10 to 3.

In so much as Personal Water Crafts have dramatically changed over the years from their initial introduction and are now quieter, far more stable, and able to maintain their stability at a speed of 5 mph, the Springs CAC recommends the Town Board re-evaluate the prohibition of launching said water vehicles at the 6 town launching ramps for the sole purpose of accessing open water.

The Town subsequently heard our recommendation but did not act upon it. The SCAC has been asked to consider passing another resolution to the same effect.

Please give some thought to this issue as we will be discussing it.
