IV. Open issues

- a) **Presentation by Dell Cullum – East Hampton Town Roadside Trash Elimination:** Dell presented a thorough report on litter and dumping in the Town and how we can better our process to get violators. He would like Justice Tekulsky to give out more community service tasks to violators and assign them to Dell for clean-up duties. Uncovered dumpsters and trucks which create debris on our roads should be ticketed. Dell suggested a Litter Constable for the Town and a person at the dump to ticket anyone coming in with an uncovered truck.
- b) **Student participation – Volunteer work, credits for college:** Mali Gruber has already graduated high school and Liam is willing to do community service for Bridgehampton HS. Kathleen will give him a sheet to bring to the school to clarify credit for service to the Town Litter and Recycling Committee for EH.
- c) **Adopt-A-Road:** Volunteers will distribute flyers to all the Chambers, Libraries, CACs, etc.
- d) **Carry In/Carry Out** – Sylvia Overby to discuss the results of litter reduction on beaches and trails tracked by Scott Wilson, Andy Gaites, and

Andy Drake in the Land Management Department. Update needed especially on the trails for August meeting.

e) Banning Styrofoam:

1. Sylvia to present Town Attorney's draft legislation to the Town Board. This will be presented in September to the Board.
2. Discuss ability to create a Power Point presentation to the Town Board at the August meeting.

f) Tenant Litter:

Secondary recycling permit option that homeowners can use to increase recycling and reduce litter caused by their renters was discussed. The permit is \$40.00 and the renter's license plate number must be registered. Kathleen will send a letter to the Town Board. Dell suggested a 30 day rental sticker. Landlords are responsible for recycling.

- g) Straws** – Michael Dadurra added a “Thank you for Caring and Doing” to the Fee Schedule paper one gets with permit. Liam will work with Kathleen to write a script for a PSA and do a radio spot for WLNG.
