NOTICE

To Whom It May Concern:

After consulting with the FAA, counsel, consultants, and the public, the Town Board of the Town of East Hampton has voted to close the East Hampton Airport (HTO). This closure will occur at 11:59 p.m. on May 17, 2022. All air navigation facilities at HTO—including but not limited to the runways, taxiways, navigational aids, runway lighting, taxiway lighting, instrument landing approaches, and automated weather services—will be deactivated and unavailable for use after this date. A new, private use airport—the East Hampton Town Airport (JPX)—will open at 9:00 a.m. on May 19, 2022. Upon opening, all safety and operational capabilities of HTO will be available at JPX.

All leaseholders, licensees, or other occupants at HTO will have the same legal status at JPX and will be subject to the same contractual terms already in place. No new agreements or arrangements will be provided or required as the Town will remain the owner and operator of JPX.

JPX will be governed by newly enacted Rules and Regulations. The Rules and Regulations are available for review at Town Hall, at the Airport, and on the Town's Website. Compliance with the Rules and Regulations is mandatory.
