**Recruitment Information:**

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

•Minimum age: 19 years on the date of the written Suffolk County Civil Service Police exam to be eligible for appointment. Maximum age: 34 years on the date of the written exam. (Applicants with active military duty, as defined in Section 243 (10-a) of the New York State Military Law, may deduct up to six years from their age to meet the maximum age requirement).

•Graduation from a standard senior high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma recognized by the New York State Department of Education, by the date of appointment. (No college required for appointment).

•Possession of a valid New York State operator's or chauffeur's license at the time of appointment.

•Candidates who attain a reachable passing grade will have to pass the following qualifying tests and evaluations: Medical, Personality Assessment (Psychological), Polygraph, Extensive Background Check, Physical Fitness Screening. Spanish speaking applicants are eligible to take the "Police Officer (Spanish Speaking)" exam for no additional fee. This exam is given at the same time as the Police Officer exam, and once graded, applicants will be ranked in order and receive a position on both the "Police Officer" list and the "Police Officer (Spanish Speaking)" list.

•Candidate must be a NY State resident and a US citizen at time of appointment. EHTPD hires from a local eligibility list with candidates who prove Town of East Hampton residency.

**SALARY & BENEFITS:**

•Starting Salary \$55,185.38 annually, increasing incrementally to \$120,037.88 after six (6) years of service. Employee contributes 3% Retirement and 15% of Health Benefits.

**PROMOTIONS & APPOINTMENTS:**

•Promotion Opportunities: Ten (10) First line supervisors as civil service rank Police Sergeant, after 3 years of service, 3 Lieutenants and 1 Captain 6 Detectives promoted by appointment.
