



# PSEG/LIPA Delivery & Power Rates


PSEG/LIPA Monthly Rate Fluctuations (prior 12 months)




# PSEG/LIPA Power Rates

# Additional CCA Questions

1. Can you opt-in or opt-out at any time? Is there any penalty for changing back and forth?
2. Are people who opt-in getting the same energy as people who opt-out? Will rates go down as more people opt-in?
3. Given the energy resources available to us now what percentage of green energy can we expect if 100% of consumers opt-in?
4. What percentage of our bills will be transmission costs as opposed to the actual cost of the energy?
5. Will there be a differential between peak and non-peak usage as there is in other communities?
6. East Hampton has explored joining with Southampton and possibly Brookhaven in forming a CCA. What is the status of those explorations and is there an optimum number of participants to make a CCA most effective?
