§ 319 Miscellaneous Provisions

Article 11

11. Mailboxes

If a property owner places his or her mailbox in the Village's highway right-of-way, the village is not liable for damage to the mailbox if the damage is caused by the village's non-negligent snow removal.

Rural mailboxes should not be so placed as to interfere with efficient snow removal; no legal authority to place a mailbox in the right of way.
