EAST HAMPTON TOWN BOARD TO RESUME IN-PERSON MEETINGS as of JULY 1

Virtual meeting technology (ZOOM) and call-in public comment number, utilized during COVID-19 pandemic, will continue to be available

The East Hampton Town Board will resume meetings in person at Town Hall, 159 Pantigo Road, East Hampton, as of July 1, following a shift to virtual meetings during the COVID-19 pandemic.

Members of the public may attend the meetings at Town Hall.
Those who are unvaccinated must wear masks.

Remote ZOOM meeting technology will continue to be used for members of the board or presenters who cannot appear in person.

The call-in number for public comment, at 351-888-6331, will remain in use for members of the public who do not attend in person.

However, per New York State regulations, all comments on Public Hearing matters must be made in person or in writing to the Town Clerk at CBrennan@EHamptonny.gov, or by mail to Carole Brennan, 159 Pantigo Road, East Hampton NY 11937.

Callers who wish to comment on Public Hearing matters will be instructed to submit their comments in writing, and hearings will be held open for one week to allow for receipt of comments.

The meetings will continue to be broadcast live on local cable station LTV channel 22, on LTV's YouTube channel, and live-streamed at LTVeh.org, and can be viewed at any time using the LTV website.

The Town's appointed boards (Planning Board, Zoning Board of Appeals, Architectural Review Board and Licensing Review Boards) are also to resume in-person meetings.
